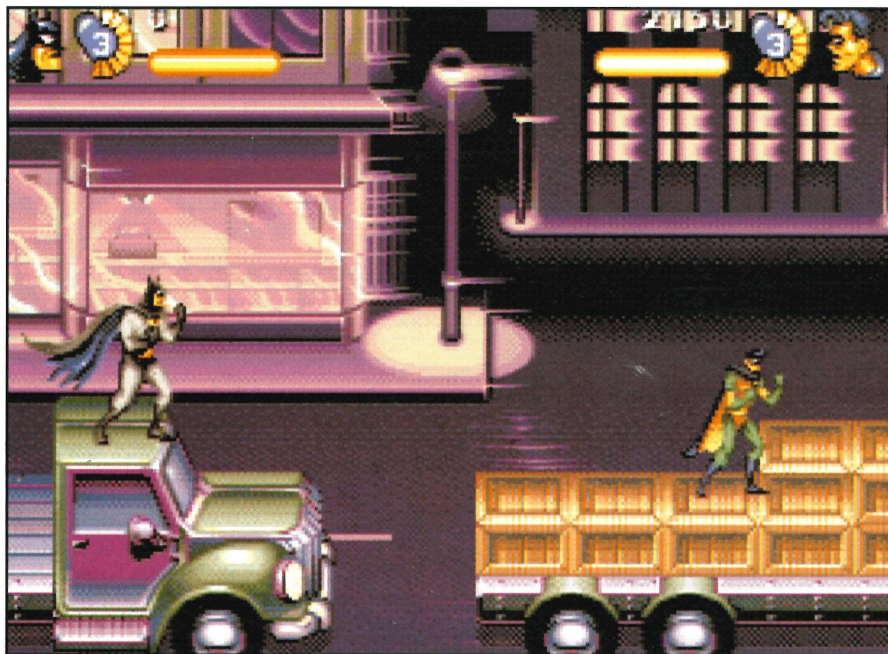


# THE ADVENTURES OF BATMAN AND ROBIN

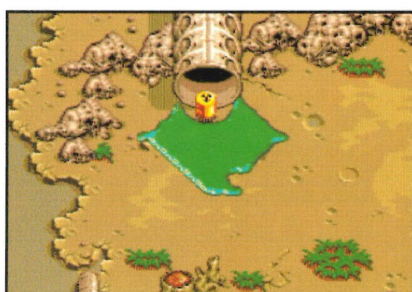
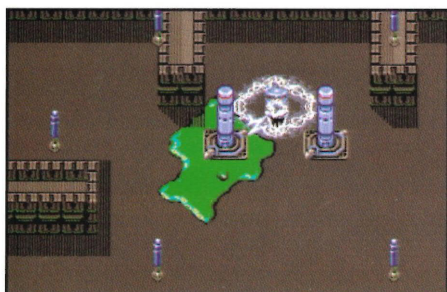
# ALIEN SOLDIER

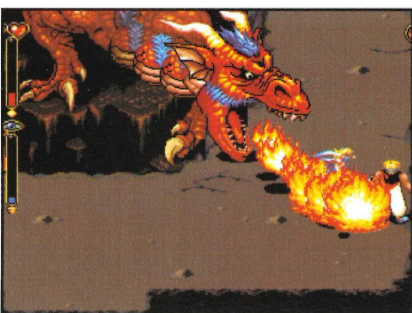

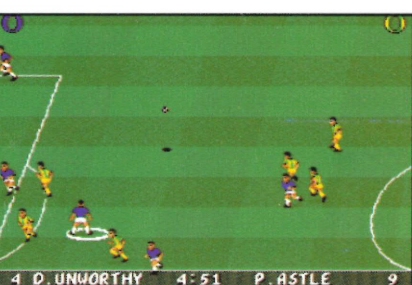
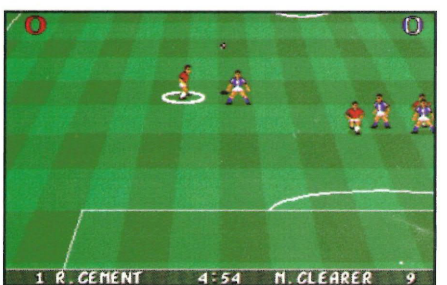
# THE OOZE

Featuring play modes for both one and two gamers, Knuckles Chaotix is a major league Mega Drive 32X release.



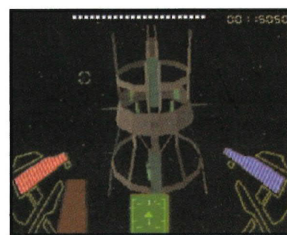
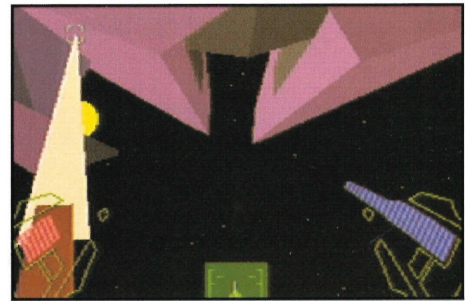
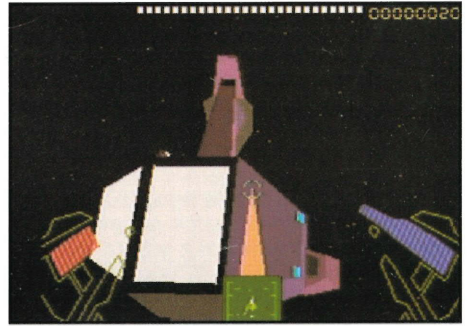
