SUPER NES

The Super Nintendo has continued to flourish even though the Genesis is beginning to serve up some serious competition in the game category. Nintendo's own Super Metroid was quite a surprise hit and it was nice to see Stunt Race FX (previously known as FX Trax) nearing completion. Other companies are beginning to break into previously untapped game ideas. Domark and U.S. Gold have created action games that star a character who uses soccer balls as his main attack. Cartoon

characters are still big hits with game developers. Just a portion of this list includes Itchy & Scratchy, Popeye, Mickey Mouse, Fievel, Superman, Ren & Stimpy and the Flintstones. Although the majority falls in the action category, it's still a big hit with gamers. This year, the Super NES will be offering games in every category to keep players busy for months to come. Of course, more RPGs are on their way as well, with Square Soft releasing Breath of Fire and Final Fantasy III this year.

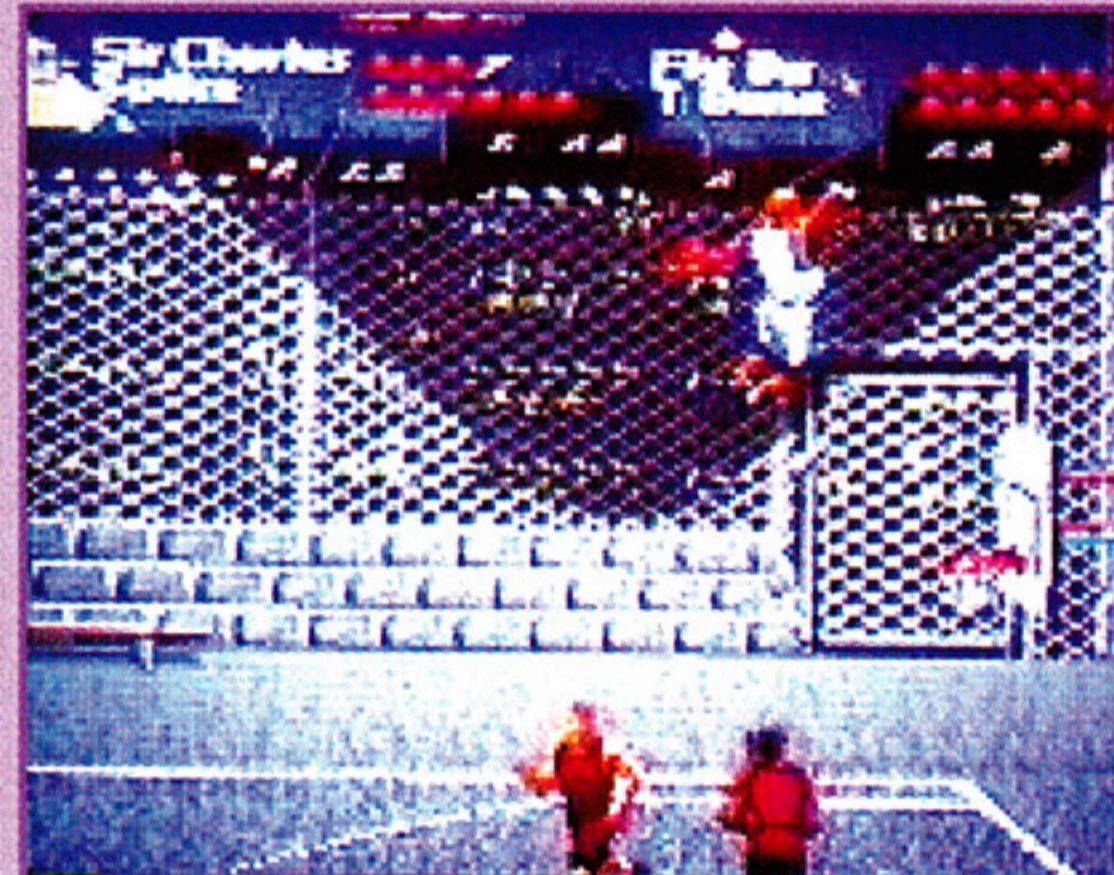
GENESIS
