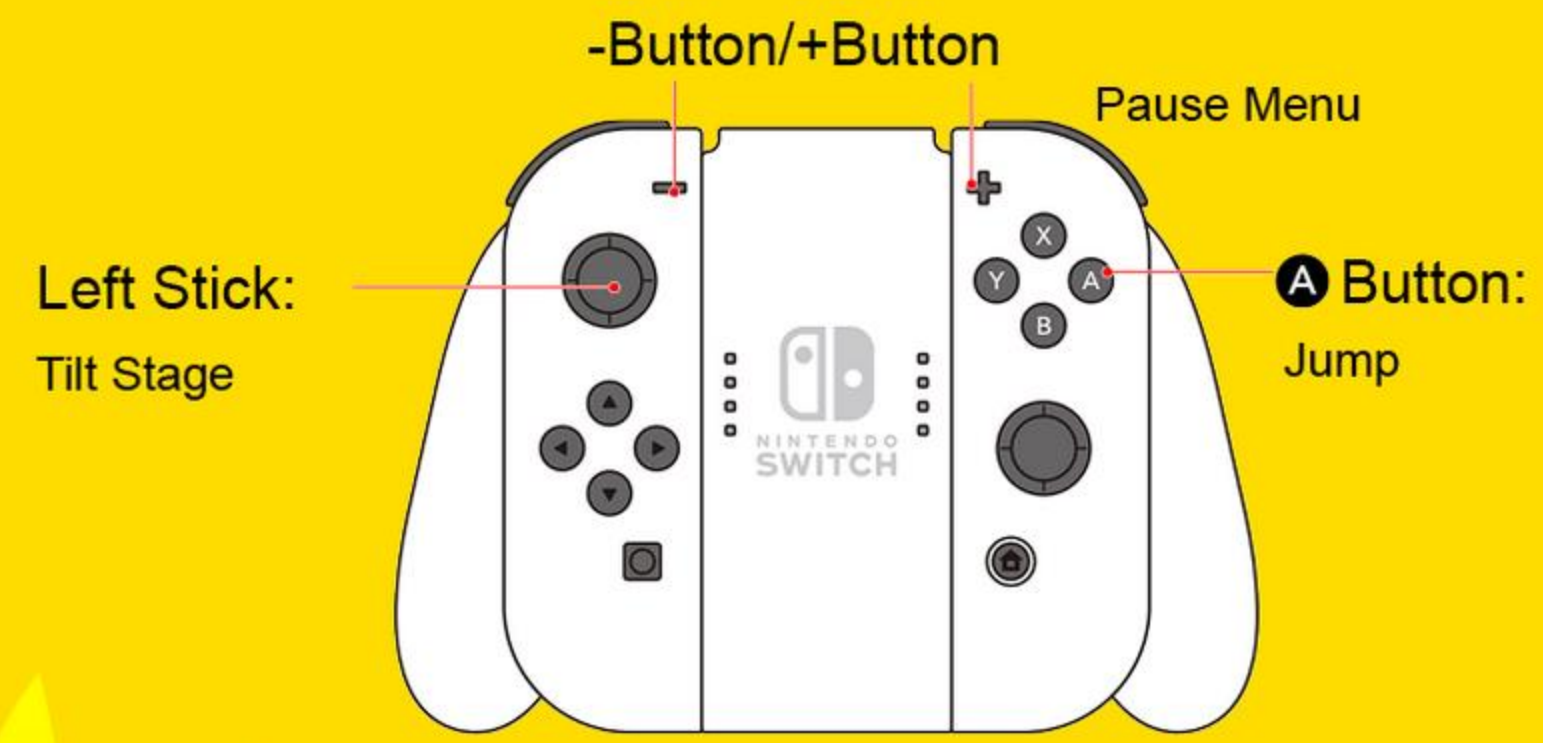

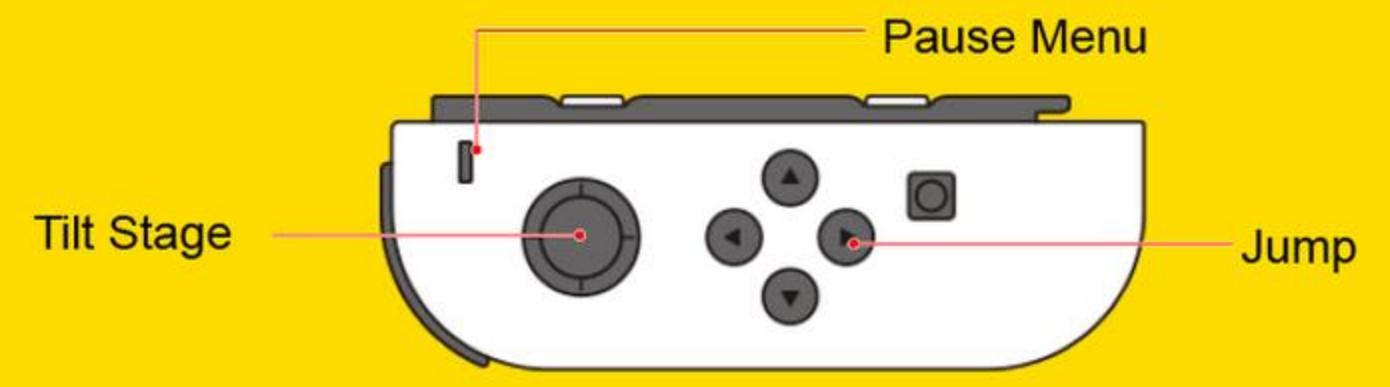

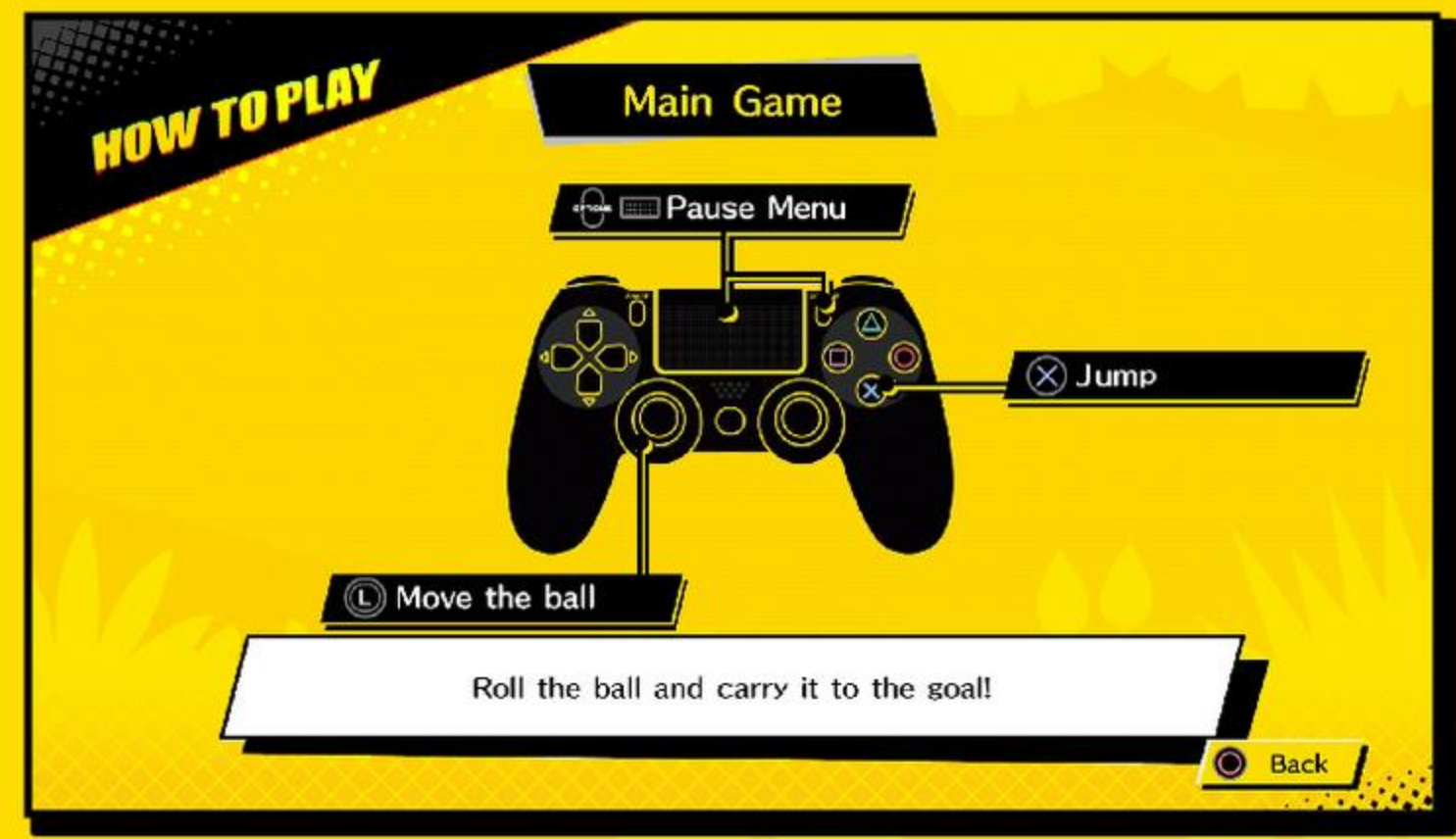

Party Game Controls

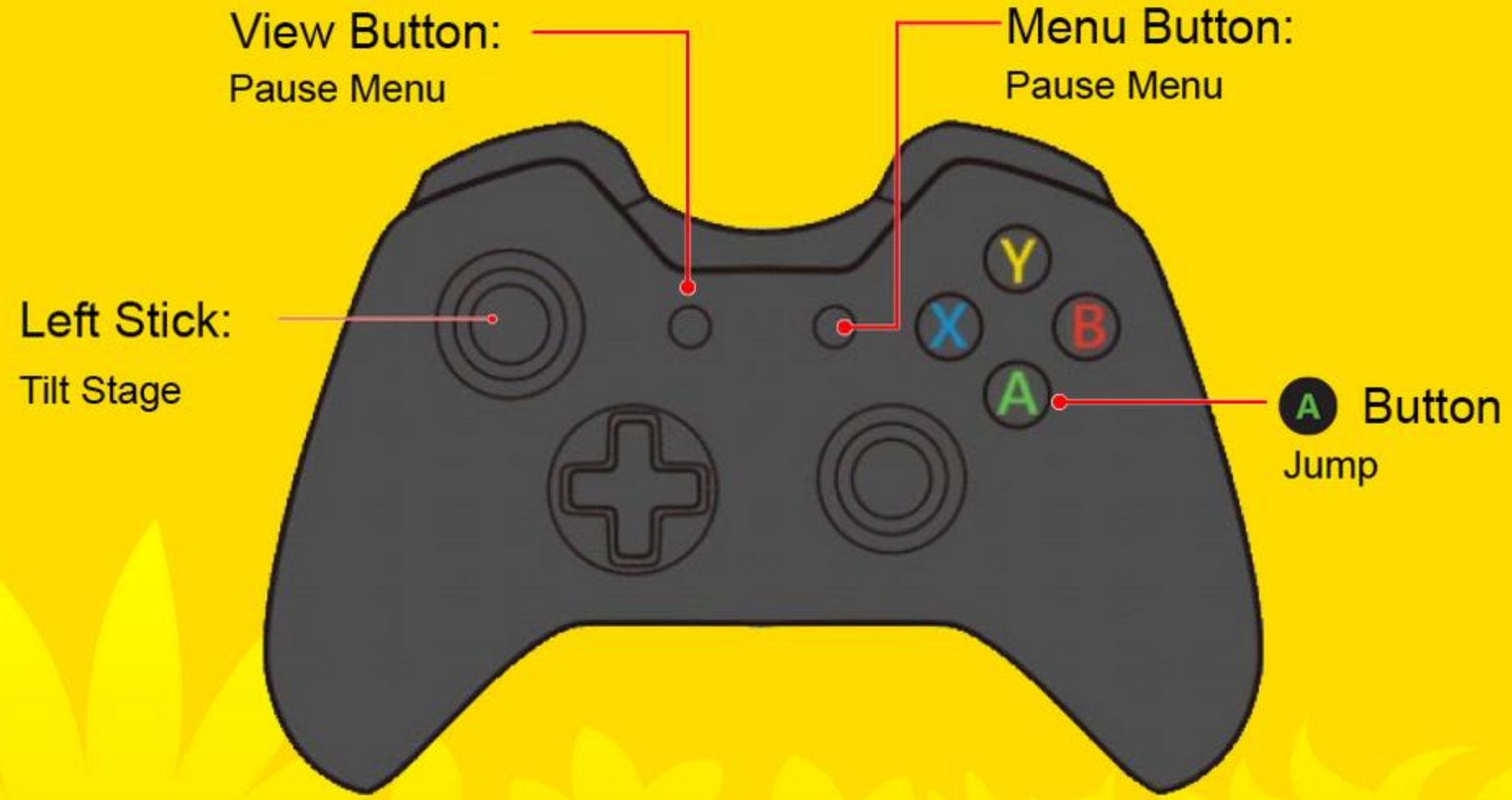
For Party Games, controls will be displayed before each game starts.

Main Game

This is the main single-player mode.

Character Select

Start off by choosing a character. Each has their own strengths and weaknesses. If you get stuck on a stage, try it fresh with a different monkey!



AiAi

Balanced type with average jump and speed. He's a good monkey to start off with, given his normal stats.



MeeMee

A balanced-type, similar to AiAi. However, she's a little better at jumping.



Baby

Being an infant, he uses the smallest, lightest ball, which allows for greater speed.



GonGon

He uses the biggest, heaviest ball, letting him plow into obstacles with hardly a care in the world. However, his jumping and speed aren't so hot.



YanYan

Though she isn't the fastest, her jumping is top-notch. Beware of obstacles though, as she gets bounced around easily.



Doctor

Despite his advanced years, he's the fastest of the bunch! Just the slightest tilt and he's off to the races.

There will be more characters to choose from as you progress further in the game.

Main Game

Worlds and Stages

Next, choose your world. Although World 1 will be your only option at first, as you complete each world, a new one will unlock. There are eight worlds in total.

Each world consists of eight stages. Completing four of them will trigger a bonus stage—your chance to grab a bunch more bananas!



Once you clear all eight stages, it's time to face the boss. Find its weak point, then hurl yourself at it via jumping or other means. Defeating a world's boss completes that world.



Clear Medals and Champion Medals

Completing all stages of a world for the first time will earn you a Clear Medal. Additionally, if you complete all stages of a world in order and without using a continue, you'll earn a Champion Medal!

You will see a medal icon and the text "In Progress" displayed at the top left corner of the screen while you are en route to getting a Champion Medal. Choosing "Stage Select" or "Retry" will abandon any progress toward a Champion Medal.



Time Attack

In this mode, you can compete against other players worldwide for the fastest clear time. Play all stages of a world in order and compare your overall clear time with other players.

Course Select

Once you choose your character, you choose your course. Choose from the three courses below.



Casual Course - You can choose this course from the beginning. Play all stages of World 1 in order.

Standard Course - This course will become available as you progress in the game. Play all stages of Worlds 1-5 in order.

Expert Course - This course will become available as you progress in the game. Play all stages of the Main Game in order.

Time Attack Rules

The basic rule is the same as it is in the Main Game, but if you choose to Retry when you're out of tries, you'll restart from the first stage of each course (your time will be reset as well).



Once you clear the final stage of each course, your total time will be displayed and entered into the rankings (network connection required).



Decathlon

In this mode, you can play 10 Party Games in a row and compete against other players worldwide for the highest overall score.

Once you choose your character, you'll be taken to the list of Party Games. You'll be playing all the games in sequence from beginning to end.

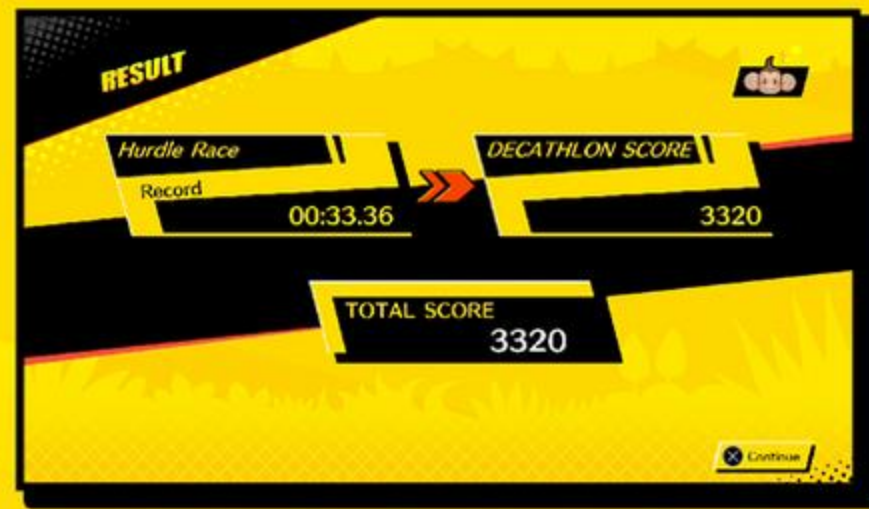


As you finish each game, you'll be taken back to the list of Party Games, where you can see your total score. Once you're ready to continue, move on to the next game.

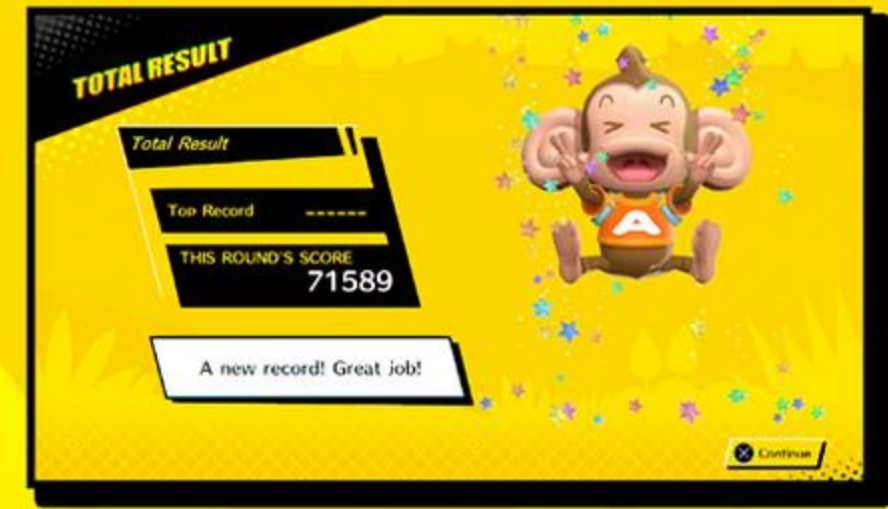


Decathlon Rules

The basic rules are the same as in the regular Party Games, but the results will be converted into a common score, then added together. Also, there is no "game over" in any of the games. If your game ends due to time running out, your result will be converted and added to your score.

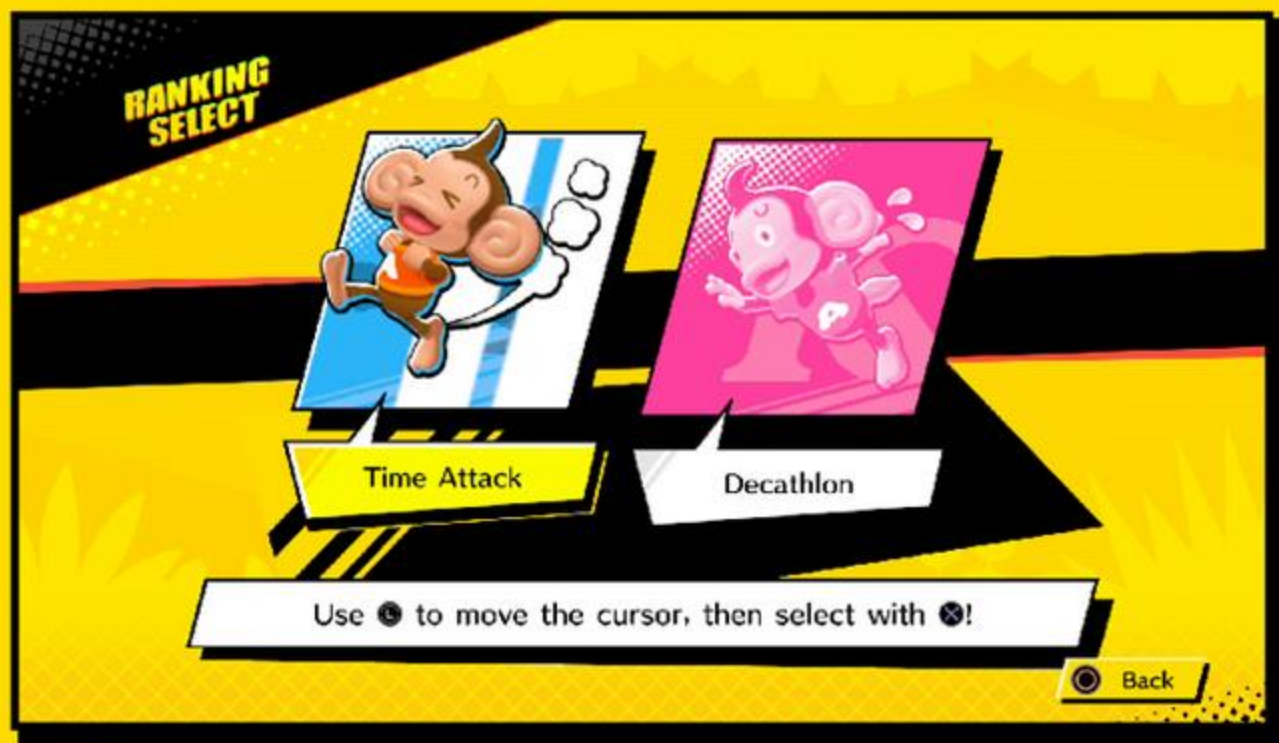


Once you clear all Party Games, your total score will be displayed and entered into the rankings (network connection required).

For each mode, you can switch between Friend Ranking and World Ranking views.
