JOHN MADDEN FOOTBALL

Select a field goal on the fourth down and aim either far right or far left for the side line. If the ball lands on it you'll get three points as opposed to the usual one. 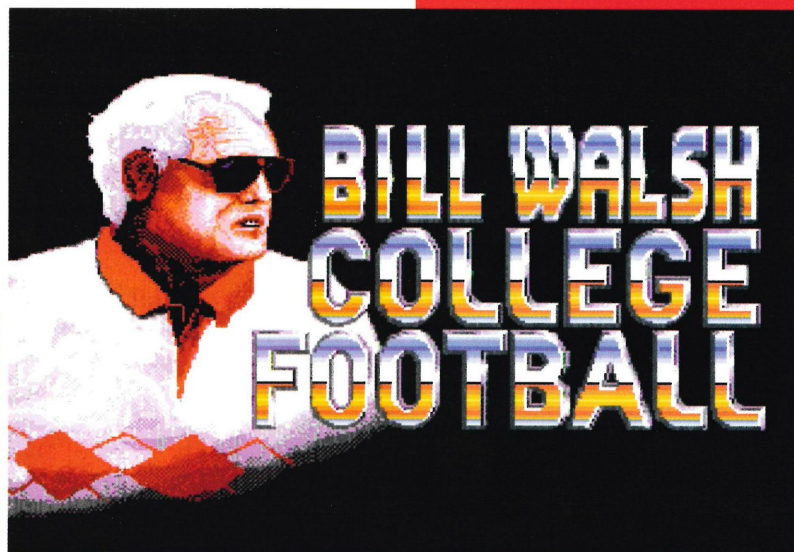

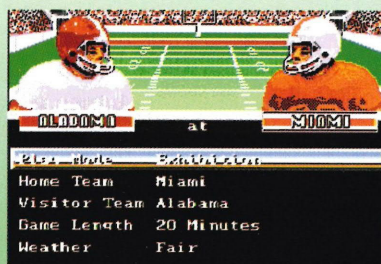
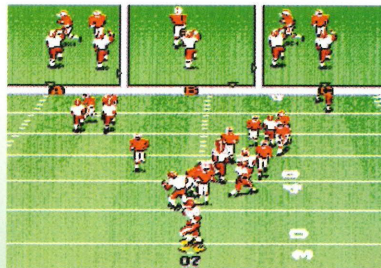


BILL WALSH COLLEGE FOOTBALL

Here's a little lesson that applies to both *Bill Walsh* games. Choose the Miami '91 team, they're generally regarded as one of the toughest teams all-round, and have the hardest defense about. When playing offense, use the Play Action pass or the ordinary Play Action and you should normally advance 35 yards or so without much bother. Also, when passing choose the player in box B as he's generally in the clear.

As for the defense, the two Cheat plays (left and right) tend to have the best effects. Choose either No 8 or 31, as these two stay away from the pack.

This may sound like a strange tactic, but what you should be doing is concentrating on picking off receivers and let the computer controlled players handle sacking the quarterback and runners. Okay?

EA Sports Tips

NBA SHOWDOWN



Here's the best way of scoring a basket – and it demonstrates the control a player can have over the whole team by using the new coaching options. Play two teams like the Bulls and Suns, they're performers who know how to put on a show.

After the game starts, press START and select coaching options by pressing Ⓚ. Press Right to turn Playcalling on, go down to Offensive Plays and press Ⓞ to get the Offensive Plays menu. Select 'Give and Go' by pressing Ⓞ and return to the game (START).

The next time you cross the halfway line with the ball press Ⓞ, 'GIG' should flash up in the top right corner of the screen, signifying that your team have heard the call. Pass to a player who's down the side of the court and you'll have control of him. Don't move.

The player who passed to you will now run into the key and stand under the basket – press B to pass to him – now press and hold A to dunk, and if you're lucky you'll draw the foul and get the free throw screen. Every time you get the ball you can follow this procedure from the halfway line.

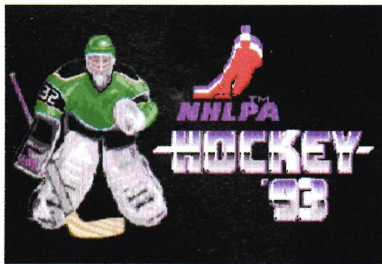




When Electronic Arts launched their auxiliary branch EA Sports, the brief was to make a range

of sports simulations that were as authentic and realistic as technology would allow. The aim was world domination.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF WORLD DOMINATION



EA Sports' ice hockey games have been best sellers in the US, and interest is growing in the UK

Whatever the game, the idea was to allow the player to call the shots and make the play, to feel the knocks and the excitement you can only find in fast moving sports. This is the approach that gave rise to EA Sports' adage: 'If it's in the game, it's in the game.'

John Madden's Football hit the Mega Drive in 1990. Rather than making a running-and-throwing game, EA Sports decided that the strategy of playing tactical move after move, and the psychology of second guessing your opponent's play was the most important element of American football. And what a result! John Madden gave the game's developers the benefit of his experience and was also involved in the improvements for updated games. As the series evolved, the graphics, sound and animation got smoother and more plays were introduced. By 1994 came the NFL licence and a full 16 week season.

For a different approach to the game, EA Sports developed *Bill Walsh*

College Football, a quick game that throws you into the grass roots of the sport. It's very much the mud-and-grind realism of college football, with college rules and competitions, plus a choice of plays to call on audibles.

CRUNCHING TACKLE

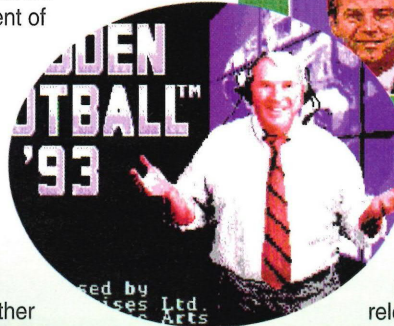
EA Sports next set about conquering the world of ice hockey, sending *NHL* and then *NHPLA Hockey* storming up the charts. Complete player rosters mean that every crunching tackle and slap shot are under the direct control of the player. This feeling of involvement combined with the excitement of playing amongst the real all-time greats in exhibition and tournaments matches suck you in like no other game.

The EA Sports machine moved on to another popular, yet very different sport – golf. Once again EA took the advice (along with the licence) of the official body and made the strategy, skill and mass of realistic settings and statistics core game elements. *PGA Tour* and its successor *PGA 2* have recently been complemented by *PGA European Tour* which incorporates all the European courses and players, and has become massively popular over here in the UK.

The other big US sport that's enjoying a massive boom over here is



Not only is EA Sports' faithful commentator Ron Barr fluent in six languages including German, he also regularly challenges John Madden for the best dressed sports personality of the year. No, really



basketball. EA have produced a number of releases with the emphasis on gameplay skills and strategy. EA Sports have built on the successes of the earlier EASN titles to produce the biggest and best basketball game to date – *NBA Showdown*.

4-WAY PLAY

With the popularity of multi-player games sweeping the Mega Drive, EA's 4-Way Play has been busy since its release in November 1993 spicing up the latest sports releases – *NHL '94*, *NBA Showdown*, *Bill Walsh*, *Madden*

'94 and of course, let's not forget *that* football game.

THAT FOOTBALL GAME

FIFA International Soccer is a massive selling and technically brilliant game, and not only that, it's also beautifully playable. The TV-like isometric 3D view, the 2000 frames of animation and the 48 full squads, together with the lightening pace and atmosphere of a real football stadium made sure *FIFA International Soccer* was sold clear off the shelves of all the major games retailers last Christmas.

What was it we were saying about world domination? ®

Phwoar! Eh?
