IDEO games fans have given a trigger-blasting thumbs up to Sega's Mega CD.

At the beginning of the month Britain was chosen as the first country in Europe to get the groundbreaking add-on for the Mega Drive.


Only 70,000 units were shipped into the UK and the Japanese games giants held their breath to see if the £270 compact disc games player would take off.

Now they wish they had ordered more. Says a spokesman for Sega Europe: "We are not getting another shipment into Britain until September.

"And judging by the speed the Mega CD is being snapped up our existing stocks could be gone by the end of May.

"It's rather like Madonna's sex book. We have put out a limited edition and now we have seen how the market is moving we will release greater numbers of Mega CDs later in the year."

Originally it had been hoped to sell the Mega CD in the UK for less than £200 but

the devaluation of the pound last year put paid to that.

Not that it mattered. Diehard games fans realise it heralds the future of gaming.

Here is what the Mega CD has to offer:

Most Mega Drive cartridge games are eight Mbits. A CD can contain more than 500 times that.

Instead of a small sound spectrum it uses quality sound just like an audio CD and has no problem handling perfect speech.

Of course, if it is hooked up through your hi-fi the Mega CD doubles as an audio CD player so you can also play albums.

Graphically it allows special effects never before seen on the Mega" Drive and feeds the machine with uninterrupted information.

HAT means future CD games will be much larger and have more levels than on an ordinary cart.

It also means real digitised film footage can be used to enhance the atmosphere of the games.

Mega CD games are still in their infancy but the future looks so bright we could soon be wearing Virtual Reality shades.

Here are some of the new games planned for this year: DRACULA: A real film W footage game based on Francis Ford Coppola's movie starring Gary Oldman.

JURASSIC PARK: W Another real film footage epic, from the Spielberg movie.

NIGHT TRAP: A massive two-disc game filmed especially for the Mega CD with a mind-blowing 900Mbytes of info.

VIRTUA: A virtual VCR game that is like Lawnmower Man for the Mega CD.

SHERLOCK HOLMES 2: With three new baffling cases.

ICHAEL JACKSON'S are full of colour and action and can cost hundreds of thousands of pounds. More modestly, Madonna and George Michael have both released ones in black and white.

The rock video is essential to making hit records and, some might argue, even more creative than the music itself.

Until now, only top directors have had the cash and the clout to make videos. But the Mega CD will change all that.

Sega is set to release a whole range of Make Your Own Videos.

The first stars Kriss Kross with actual film footage and sound. Others on the way feature Marky Mark and The Funky Bunch; INXS; U2; Prince and C & C Music Factory.

The idea is perhaps the most revolutionary yet because it allows the player full scope in creating an entirely new piece of software.

And it is a boost for the faltering music business that has been hit hard by the games

Says a spokesman for Sega: "It is a major breakthrough for both the games and music industry and gives the player a chance to be the director of a pop video. "You get between three and five songs on each CD and then you are asked to make the video in a specific way.

"For instance, you might have to make one with as much Marky Mark as you can without his shirt on. Or perhaps one featuring him with as many fast cars as possible.

"It's up to you to edit the footage to make the best video you can, using strobe lights, lyrics, cutting and editing devices and other visual effects.

Favourites

"Your efforts will then be marked by the Mega Drive."

The Make Your Own Video CDs will be released at the rate of one a month at a cost of around £40 each.

Contemporary stars will be followed, it is hoped, by old favourites such as the Jimi Hendrix Experience or the Bea-

"This is only the beginning," Sega says. "The horizons are infinite, and we hope to move on to Make Your Own Pop Record very soon.

"We think the CDs are already good value for money but

expect the price to fall as the market expands.

"If you bought a Marky Mark CD and a Marky Mark video you would be looking at nearly £30. For an extra tenner you get both – plus the chance to mix them into something totally new."

We had a look at the Make Your Own Kriss Kross Video, priced at £39.99.

Most of the footage comes from three boxes at the bottom of the screen. They are controlled by buttons A, B and C and switching between them couldn't be easier.

There are lots of strange images, including promos of the group, women and monsters. Just by flicking the buttons you can make something utterly surreal. But it doesn't gel and it's down to you to get the breaks scrolling smoothly.

Above these boxes is the finished footage box which lets you see what you are creating as you go along.

And to the left is the effects box which lets you do just about anything - flip the screen over, break it into stripes. freeze the action, strobe the frames, go into slow motion, blowing up the pixels, and even jumble everything up.

Creative

The package offers excellent creative fun. And, thanks to the battery back-up, you can save your masterpiece to bore your friends with.

Unfortunately, the Kriss Kross CD contains only three songs. It would have been better to have a lot more.

The C & C Music Factory CD is due out in the early summer and is slightly more sophisticated. Apart from having better songs - well did you really like Jump! - the storyline has you helping out the backroom boys at the Music Factory.

You are told the essential parts of the video you have to make and are then let loose.


